1. INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGN "Primal chair" - FROM IDEA TO PROTOTYPE

In the period from 6 September to 16 October, the 2nd international competition for the design of a wooden chair was held as a tribute to the Kočevje primeval forest. 18 proposals by 20 authors were applied. We received seven ideas (Primal) chairs by foreign authors from France, India and Serbia.

A jury of the International Competition for Industrial Design Primal chair, in the same composition as last year, president prof. dr. Niko Torelli, prof. dr. Janez Suhadolc, Tomaž Hartman, Lela B. Njatin and Andrej Palman, chose one main award and three special mentions.

The main award went to "Chair in a picture" by Ines Rotar. The special mention of the jury went to Origin (Jurado Michael), picCHAIR (Jasna Hrovatin, Rok Hrovatin) and Panj (Snežana Jeremić).

From the selected proposals, Andrej Palman made prototypes for the selected authors and the archive of the Festival of wood, which we will promote next year.

help of professors, designed various wooden products in a one-week workshop. Then the students of Secondary Vocational School Slovenj Gradec and Muta produced them. Throughout the festival, a sales exhibition of regional designers of wooden products and products of students of the Grammar school and Secondary School Kočevje was open. On Saturday, November 19, other Slovenian creators of wooden products also presented themselves at the market.
